### N.B.

Each child will need to have his or her own stationary, sharing amongst pupils will not be allowed. To ensure that your child always has the necessary items we are asking you to purchase sufficient pencils, rubbers and pens. Single colour pens are more comfortable for children to hold, multi colours in the same pen and awkward and are not conducive to good pencil grip. To eliminate pencil cases being forgotten at home each child will need a school pencil case which will remain in school and a home pencil case which is to remain at home.

### **Uniform:**

From September 2022,  $1^{st} - 6^{th}$  will wear a pale blue shirt or polo shirt, plain navy jumper and grey pinafore or trousers. PE uniform (to be worn 2 days) is a pale blue polo shirt, plain navy tracksuit bottoms (not patterned or colourful please), a plain navy sweatshirt and runners. In warm weather, grey shorts can be worn with the uniform and plain navy shorts can be worn with the tracksuit. These items are crest-free and can be purchased in Dunnes, Tesco etc.
